

# Go!

Are you keen to spend a year serving God, serving others and growing in faith?

The *Go! Experience* is an opportunity to grow and serve as a disciple of Jesus. Through Go! You can make an impact on a local church or Christian organisation, be a part of weekly supportive and challenging community and gain a Diploma in Christian Ministry and Theology through the St. Mark's National Theological College.

Go! gives participants an opportunity to grow in understanding of the Christian faith and how it applies in everyday life. It provides workplace and leadership exposure in Christian contexts and time and space for reflection, challenge and personal growth.

Go! Participants will work weekly alongside passionate Christian leaders in real life Christian ministry gaining valuable experience. They will finish the year with a recognised qualification for further Christian ministry study and work.



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Go! is designed to be a practical year that can be done alongside whatever else it is you do, be that school, uni, work or a combination.

It's an opportunity to work alongside leaders in ministry and discover the gifts, talents and heart God has given you for serving Him and our world.

- You will meet for a day each week during school terms with the Go! Community for worship and prayer, sharing, reflection and study. It can be a big cold world. Getting together brings opportunities for deeper connection, support and the ability to learn from others
- You will serve weekly alongside a Christian leader in a local church or Christian organisation. Your work will make a difference to a local church or Christian ministry and give you invaluable practical experience.

You will have opportunities to serve others, draw aside with God, connect with people beyond the church, lead groups, gain experience in organising events, travel, work in teams and more

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## **Weekly Go! Community**

In 2017 the group will meet in Bungendore from 9.30 to 4pm. Lunch each day will be provided. The timetable will include times of worship and prayer, group study, discussion, reflection and an amazing range of guest Christian leaders sharing their areas of passion and expertise

## **Ministry Experience Placement**

People enrolled in Go! will be part of a local church or Christian ministry each week for 7-10 hours. Participants will be working with leaders and team members in a range of church and community programs.

Placements will be arranged prayerfully with each individual participant by the Go! leaders. Consideration will be given to each participant's gifts, interests and needs.

## **Costs**

The cost for Go! is \$3,500 for 12 months. This includes enrolment in the Diploma of Christian Ministry at Theology through St Marks NTC. Participants are encouraged to source finances from their local church and individuals who want to support them in ministry.
